International Games Rules

- 1. 16 minute stop clock halves for NCAA divisions and 14 minute stop clock for all other divisions. 3 minute half time. 3 minute warm up minimum.
- 2. Top team in bracket is the home team and wears light jersey.
- 3. 3 timeouts per game (do not carry over into overtime).
- 4. Shoot 1 and 1 on the 7th team foul and double bonus on the 10th team foul.
- 5. The clock will continue to run after the lead is 20 or more points. If the score differential goes back to 15 points or less then the stop clock will resume.
- 6. Overtime
 - a. 3 minute stop time with an additional time out given to each team.
 - b. The games will consist of as many overtimes as necessary to determine the winner.
 - c. 1 timeout per overtime (unused timeouts do not carry over).
- 7. 10 second back court call in effect for all divisions except NCAA divisions. The 30 second shot clock will be used for all NCAA divisions.
- 8. High school rules will be used in all other situations.
