

## TOURNAMENT RULES

## Player Eligibility:

Based on grade with unlimited age exceptions.

- For example, if a $7^{\text {th }}$ grader does not turn 13 until after September 1,2019 , he is eligible to play on a $6^{\text {th }}$ grade team.


## Team Rosters:

- All rosters must be turned in prior to your team's first game - All players will be certified at the check-in. If a player plays in a game without being certified, the team with that player will forfeit that game
- Players can only play on one team in a division


## Ball Size:

- $\quad 11 \&$ under shall use the 28.5 " circumference basketball
- $\quad 12$ \& older shall use the $29.5^{\prime \prime}$ circumference basketball


## Game Rules:

- All divisions will play 14 minute stop time halves
- 3 Time outs per game
- Teams will shoot one and one on the $7^{\text {th }}$ team foul and two shots at 10 team
fouls
- Mercy Rule - Clock will continue to run after the lead is 20 points and will stop once the lead is below 20 points
- High School Rules will be used in all other situations


## Overtime:

3 minute stop time, with an additional time-out given to each team

## Tie-Breakers:

a) Head to Head
b) Point differential - Maximum points for win is 15
c) Strength of schedule - Record against top teams

## Protests:

All protests must be made BEFORE the start of the game. Any questions pertaining to the eligibility of a player or team shall be directed to the Gym Supervisor BEFORE the start of the game. All teams must show Birth Certificates and/or report cards for verification upon request.
